Lesson:

What is a concordance?

Answer: A Bible concordance can be a helpful tool for studying the Bible. A concordance contains an alphabetical index of words used in the Bible and the main Bible references where the word occurs. A Bible concordance is useful in locating passages in the Bible. If you can remember just one word in a verse, you can often find what you're looking for.

Lets use Strongs Concordance to define the word Parable

What is the definition of parable?

3850. parabole ►

Strong's Concordance

parabole: a parable, **comparison**

3850 parabolé (from **3844** /pará, "close beside, with" and **906** /bállō, "to cast") – a parable; a teaching aid cast alongside the truth being taught. This casts additional light by using an arresting or familiar analogy, (which is often fictitious or metaphorical, but not necessarily).

What is a Teaching Aid

any device, object, or machine used by a teacher to clarify or **enliven a subject**

Parables do not change the lesson , they are devices used to enhance the comprehension of the lesson that's being conveyed

Christ sought to remove that which obscured the truth. The veil that sin has cast over the face of nature, He came to draw aside, bringing to view the spiritual glory that all things were created to reflect. His words placed the teachings of nature as well as of the Bible in a **new aspect**, and made them a **new revelation**. COL 18.3


